

7 Inspirational Scriptures to Keep You On Guard

Hope, Joy and Peace

This passage gives the ingredients of three key things that every person would want in a time like this. The word of God should bring life to the hearer/reader. Lest you forget, the author of the Book of Romans is making a solid statement here. Be reminded that hope, joy, and peace belong to you.

Romans 15:13 NIV

13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

They are coming against the wrong person

Deuteronomy 31:6 NIV

6 Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you."

Isaiah 40:31 NIV

31 but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

Get the right light

Psalm 27:1 NIV

Don't let your ego drive you out

Proverbs 3:5-6 NIV
